Thank you for your response.

The wording as suggested "Electronic surveillance apparatus, namely electromagnetic spectrum surveillance apparatus in the nature of mobile electronics" is still indefinite because it only specifies the nature of the goods however, not the type of goods which is required. Additionally, the goods "mobile electronics" may be incongruous with the nature of the goods "electronic surveillance apparatus" without further specification. The ID Manual provides further guidance.

The applicant must specify the type of electronic surveillance apparatus for example, electronic security tags and labels, etc.
