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Dear Sharon C. Sorkin,

I am also the Trademark Examining Attorney at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office examining the application for RAPTOR (Serial No. 97577131), and I would like to discuss the following requirements with you:

1. **Goods and Services Indefinite/Misclassified – Amendment Required:**

1. The wording “Providing online non-downloadable digital content, namely, automobiles, SUVs, trucks and vans, land vehicle parts and accessories, and clothing for use in online virtual worlds” in International Class 042 is indefinite and misclassified as this services appears to be an entertainment service, which would be in International Class 041.

1. I would recommend the following amendment, if accurate:

i. International Class 009: Is fine as-is.

ii. **International Class 041: Entertainment services, namely, providing on-line, non-downloadable digital content[, namely,]in the nature of virtual automobiles, SUVs, trucks and vans, land vehicle parts and accessories, and clothing for use in online virtual world[s]environments created for entertainment purposes**

If applicant agrees, I can make the changes via an Examiner’s Amendment, and the application may proceed toward registration. Please let me know if you have any questions. If I have not heard from you by **Monday, April 17, 2023**, I will issue a formal Action documenting the requirements.
