Good morning Sandra,

I am reviewing the above-referenced responses filed on June 6, 2023 in connection with these applications for your client, Panasonic Holdings Corporation. In review of these responses there is just one minor issue that can be corrected without the need for an Office action.

We require an amended identification of goods in International Class 009. Specifically, the wording "Electronic machines, namely, display units for computers and their parts and integrated circuit chips and their parts" is indefinite and must be clarified to further specify the common commercial name for display units and to specify that the parts are for replacement and structural purposes. The suggested amendment would read:

International Class 009

Electric sensors; ultrasonic sensors; alarm sensors; Measuring and testing machines and instruments, namely, coordinate measuring machines and instruments, instruments for measuring length, plastic testing machines, and gas testing instruments; Electric power distribution machines and control machines and apparatus in the nature of thermistor and automatic pressure control machines and instruments; Rotary converters; Phase modifiers; Solar batteries; Electric wires and cables; Telecommunication machines and apparatus, namely, telecommunication transmitters, fuses, indicator lights, and microphones; Personal digital assistants; Touch panels; Electronic machines, namely, display units for computers **being computer display monitors**~~and their parts~~ and integrated circuit chips and ~~their~~ **structural and replacement parts therefor**; Antennas being aerials; Sensors in the nature of conductive films specially adapted for touch screens and panels for detecting proximity, movement, and solar radiation; Sensors in the form of films for projected capacitive touch screens and panels in the nature of pollutant sensors, pressure sensors, and photoelectric sensors; Touch screen sensors being electric or electronic sensors for 3D gesture, proximity, hover, touch, movement and solar radiation; Touch screens; Computers; Computer peripheral devices; Printed circuit boards; Smartphones; Video screens; Electrical connectors for touch panels and touch screens; Electrical connectors; Regulating apparatus, electric in the nature of control units for regulating start-up electrical motors; printed wiring boards being printed circuit boards

Please let me know if you would approve of my amending the identification of goods for both applications as described above.
