## TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

And TECO hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks or other authority responsible for effectuating and/or recording assignments in the country involved, to indicate in its records that MIPI is the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the trademarks set forth in the attached Exhibit A;

And TECO agrees to execute whatever documents are deemed necessary or desirable by MIPI, its successors, assigns or legal representatives to record transfer of ownership of said trademarks from TECO to MIPI, all at the expense of MIPI or its successors, assigns or legal representatives;

And TECO further agrees that it will, at any time, upon request by MIPI, its successors, assigns or legal representatives, deliver any and all papers that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said trademarks or to enable MIPI or its successors, assigns or legal representatives to obtain and enforce protection for said trademarks, all at the expense of MIPI or its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

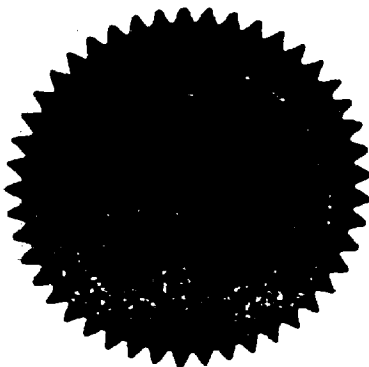
