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## TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Enterprise Coatings Company, Ltd., a Connecticut corporation (“Connecticut”), has adopted and used, and is currently using and is the owner of, all rights, title and interests in and to the trademark “Vapex” and all good will appurtenant thereto (the “Mark”); and

WHEREAS, Enterprise and Enterprise Coatings Company of Rhode Island, Ltd., a Rhode Island corporation (“Rhode Island”), have entered into a Joint Plan of Merger and Agreement of Merger dated as of December 15, 1995 to be effective December 31, 1995 (the “Merger Agreement”), pursuant to which Connecticut has agreed, among other things, to assign, and Rhode Island has agreed to acquire, all rights, title and interests in the Mark, together with the goodwill appurtenant thereto;


WHEREAS, pursuant to the Merger Agreement, Rhode Island, as the surviving corporation of the merger contemplated by the Merger Agreement, shall be renamed “Enterprise Coatings Company, Ltd.” effective as of December 31, 1995;

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Connecticut does hereby assign, sell, transfer, convey and grant to Rhode Island (to be renamed “Enterprise Coatings Company, Ltd.”), its successors and assigns, all of Connecticut’s rights, title and interests in and to the Mark, together with the goodwill appurtenant thereto.

Connecticut authorizes and requests the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and the corresponding offices of countries foreign to the United States to issue all trademark registrations which may issue with respect to the Mark to Rhode Island under the name “Enterprise Coatings Company, Ltd.”, its successors and assigns, in accordance with this Trademark Assignment.


