

ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK

This ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK is dated as of December 4, 1998 between GTE GOVERNMENT SYSTEMS CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Delaware (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR"), and TCSI CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Nevada (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE").


WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNEE have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement dated November 20, 1998 (hereinafter "the Agreement") pursuant to which ASSIGNEE agrees to purchase certain assets from ASSIGNOR, including certain trade names and trademarks;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants set forth in the Agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby assign unto ASSIGNEE all rights, title and interest in and to the aforesaid Trademarks identified in the attached Schedule A, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Trademarks, the aforesaid trademark registrations and registration applications, that portion of ASSIGNOR's business which is associated with the Trademarks, together with the right to file the Trademarks in foreign countries (subject, however, to applicable trade name and trademark laws in such foreign countries), and the right to recover damages for any past and future acts of infringement.
