INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (the "**IP Agreement**") dated as of February 4, 2000, made by JuniorNet Corporation, a Delaware corporation, ParentNet Corporation, a Delaware corporation, Lancit Media Entertainment, Ltd., a New York corporation, Frame Accurate, Inc., a New York corporation, Lancit Copyright Corporation, a Delaware corporation and The Strategy Licensing Company, Inc., a Connecticut corporation (collectively, the "**Grantors**" and each individually, a "**Grantor**"), in favor of each of the holders of Notes issued pursuant to the Purchase Agreement (as defined below) (collectively, the "**Purchasers**" and each individually, a "**Purchaser**"), and The Chase Manhattan Bank, a New York banking corporation, as collateral agent (in such capacity the "**Collateral Agent**") for the Purchasers.

WHEREAS, the Grantors and the Purchasers are parties to a Convertible Note Purchase Agreement, dated as of February 4, 2000, (as amended and in effect from time to time, the "**Purchase Agreement**");

WHEREAS, the Grantors, the Purchasers and the Collateral Agent are parties to a Security Agreement, dated as of February 4, 2000, (as amended and in effect from time to time, the "**Security Agreement**"), pursuant to which the Grantors have granted to the Purchasers a security interest in certain of the Grantors's property, including without limitation, the IP Collateral, as such term is defined below, to secure the payment and performance of the Secured Obligations, as such term is defined in the Security Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this IP Agreement is supplemental to the provisions contained in the Purchase Agreement and the Security Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Grantors hereby acknowledge as follows:

§1. Definitions. Capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined herein shall have the respective meanings provided therefor in the Purchase Agreement.

§2. Grant of Security Interest. In order to secure prompt payment and performance of the Secured Obligations, and pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Grantors hereby grant and pledge to the Collateral Agent for the ratable benefit of the Purchasers a continuing security interest in all, but only to the extent of, each Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under the following, in each

case, whether now owned or existing or hereafter acquired or arising, and wherever located (collectively, the "**IP Collateral**"):

(a) Trademarks

(i) any and all trademarks, trade names, corporate names, business names, trade styles, service marks, logos, other source or business identifiers, designs and general intangibles of like nature, and all registrations, applications, and recordings thereof, including, without limitation, registrations, recordings, and applications in the United States Patent and Trademark Office or any similar office or agency of the United States, any State thereof or any other country or any political subdivision thereof including, but not limited to those U.S. and foreign registered trademarks and applications on Schedule A hereto (the "**Trademarks**");

(ii) any reissues, extensions or renewals thereof; and

(iii) all goodwill of the Grantor and its business, products and services appurtenant to, associated with or symbolized by the Trademarks;


(b) Copyrights

(i) all copyrights arising under the laws of the United States or any other country or any political subdivision thereof, whether registered or unregistered and whether published or unpublished, all registrations and recordings thereof, and all applications in connection therewith, including, without limitation, all registrations, recordings and applications listed on Schedule B hereto; and

(ii) any reissues, extensions or renewals thereof.
