**THIRD AMENDMENT TO PATENT, TRADEMARK
AND COPYRIGHT SECURITY AGREEMENT**

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO PATENT, TRADEMARK AND COPYRIGHT SECURITY AGREEMENT ("Third Amendment") is made as of June 15, 2001, by and among MALDEN MILLS INDUSTRIES, INC., a Massachusetts corporation ("Borrower"), INDEPENDENT FURNITURE SUPPLY CO., INC., a Massachusetts corporation ("IFS"), ADS PROPERTIES CORP., a Vermont corporation ("ADS"), AES PROPERTIES CORP., a Vermont corporation ("AES"), MALDEN MILLS DISTRIBUTORS CORP., a Massachusetts corporation ("Malden Distributors"), MALDEN MILLS FSC, INC., a Virgin Islands corporation ("FSC"), MALDEN MILLS OF CANADA LIMITED, a Canadian corporation ("Malden Canada"), and MALDEN MILLS GMBH, a German limited liability company ("Malden GmbH") (Borrower, IFS, ADS, AES, Malden Distributors, FSC, Malden Canada, and Malden GmbH being referred to collectively as "Grantors" and each individually as a "Grantor"), in favor of SPECIAL VALUE INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT, LLC, as agent (in such capacity, "Agent") for the lenders (collectively, "Lenders") under the Term Loan Agreement (as defined below).

RECITALS

A. Pursuant to that certain Credit Agreement dated as of October 28, 1999, as amended to date, by and among Grantors, the other credit parties party thereto, the lenders from time to time signatory thereto (the "Senior Lenders"), and General Electric Capital Corporation, as agent (in such capacity, "Senior Agent") for Senior Lenders (including all annexes, exhibits and schedules thereto, and as the same may be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), Senior Agent and Senior Lenders are providing certain financial accommodations to or for the direct or indirect benefit of Grantors. The obligations of Grantors under the Credit Agreement and the other Loan Documents as defined therein (collectively, the "Senior Loan Documents") are secured by senior security interests in substantially all of the tangible and intangible assets of Grantors.

B. Grantors, Lenders and Agent are parties to that certain Term Loan Agreement dated as of October 28, 1999, as amended to date (such Term Loan Agreement, as so amended, the "Term Loan Agreement"), pursuant to which Agent and Lenders are providing financial accommodations to or for the benefit of Borrower upon the terms and conditions contained therein. Unless otherwise defined herein, capitalized terms or matters of construction defined or established in Annex A to the Term Loan Agreement shall be applied herein as defined or established therein.

C. Grantors and Agent are parties to that certain Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement dated as of October 28, 1999, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement dated as of May 26, 2000, and that certain Second Amendment to Patent, Trademark and Copyright Agreement dated as of December 27, 2000 (collectively, the "Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement"), pursuant to which each Grantor granted a Lien on the "Intellectual Property Collateral" (as

defined therein) to Agent, for the benefit of Agent and Lenders, in accordance with the terms thereof.

D. Grantors and Agent desire (I) to correct the reference to the registration number for the Polar Zone Trademark set forth in Part B of Schedule I to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, and (II) to supplement Schedule I to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, subject to the terms and conditions of this Third Amendment.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. Confirmation of Grant of Security Interest in Intellectual Property Collateral. Each Grantor hereby ratifies and confirms, as of the date hereof, the continuing validity of the Liens granted by it under the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, as modified hereby.
2. Ratification and Incorporation of Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement. Except as expressly modified under this Third Amendment, (a) each Grantor hereby acknowledges, confirms and ratifies all of the terms and conditions set forth in, and all of its obligations under, the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, and (b) all of the terms and conditions set forth in the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement are incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full herein.
3. Subordination. The parties hereto hereby acknowledge and agree that (a) the Liens now or hereafter held by Agent, for the benefit of Agent and Lenders, in and to any of the assets or property of any Grantor, including the Intellectual Property Collateral, are and shall be subject and subordinate in priority to the Liens now or hereafter held by Senior Agent, for benefit of Senior Agent and Senior Lenders, in and to any such assets or property, and (b) the rights of Agent and Lenders hereunder are subject and subordinate to the rights of Senior Agent and Senior Lenders under the Credit Agreement and the other Senior Loan Documents, in each case pursuant to the subordination provisions set forth in Section 9 of the Term Loan Agreement.
4. Amendments to Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement. The Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) Part B of Schedule I to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement is hereby amended by (i) deleting the reference to "1,391,494" as the Reg. No. for Polar Zone in the fifth row from the bottom of page 4 of the Trademarks/Trademark Registrations section thereof for Malden Mills Industries, Inc. and (ii) substituting "1,890,580" in lieu thereof so that after giving effect to such amendment such row appears as set forth in Appendix A hereto.
 - (b) Schedule I to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement is hereby supplemented by Supplement II attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. Entire Agreement. This Third Amendment, together with the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, is the entire agreement between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof. This Third Amendment supersedes all prior and contemporaneous oral and written agreements and discussions with respect to the subject matter hereof. Except as otherwise expressly modified herein, the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

6. Miscellaneous.

(a) Counterparts. This Third Amendment may be executed in identical counterpart copies, each of which shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Third Amendment by facsimile transmission shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart thereof.

(b) Headings. Section headings used herein are for convenience of reference only, are not part of this Third Amendment, and are not to be taken into consideration in interpreting this Third Amendment.

(c) Recitals. The recitals set forth at the beginning of this Third Amendment are true and correct, and such recitals are incorporated into and are a part of this Third Amendment.

(d) Governing Law. This Third Amendment shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York applicable to contracts made and performed in such state, without regard to the principles thereof regarding conflict of laws.

(e) Effect. Upon the effectiveness of this Third Amendment, from and after the date hereof, each reference in the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement to "this Agreement," "hereunder," "hereof," or words of like import shall mean and be a reference to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement as amended hereby and each reference in the other SCIL Documents to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, "thereunder," "thereof," or words of like import shall mean and be a reference to the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement as amended hereby.


(f) No Novation. Except as expressly provided in this Third Amendment, the execution, delivery, and effectiveness of this Third Amendment shall not (i) limit, impair, constitute a waiver of, or otherwise affect any right, power, or remedy of Agent or any Lender under the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement or any other SCIL Document, (ii) constitute a waiver of any provision in the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement or in any of the other SCIL Documents, or (iii) alter, modify, amend, or in any way affect any of the terms, conditions, obligations, covenants, or agreements contained in the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, all of which are ratified and affirmed in all respects and shall continue in full force and effect.

(g) Conflict of Terms. In the event of any inconsistency between the provisions of this Third Amendment and any provision of the Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement, the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment shall govern and control.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Third Amendment to Patent, Trademark and Copyright Security Agreement to be duly executed and delivered as of the date first written above.
