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**TRADEMARK COLLATERAL SECURITY AGREEMENT**

**THIS TRADEMARK COLLATERAL SECURITY AGREEMENT** (this "Assignment"), is made by and between AMERICAN LAFRANCE, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Grantor"), and PATRIARCH PARTNERS AGENCY SERVICES, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, as agent (in such capacity, the "Agent") for itself and the financial institutions party to the Credit Agreement referenced below.

**WHEREAS**, Grantor has adopted, used and is using, and is the sole owner of the marks set forth on Schedule 1 hereof (collectively, the "Marks");

**WHEREAS**, under the terms of, and as a condition precedent to the effectiveness of, that certain Credit Agreement, dated as of December 14, 2005, among American LaFrance, LLC, as borrower, and the lenders from time to time party thereto (collectively, the "Lenders") and Agent (as amended, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), the Grantor entered into the Security Agreement dated as of even date therewith (the "Security Agreement");

**WHEREAS**, to secure the due and prompt payment and performance of the Obligations (as defined in the Security Agreement), Grantor pledged, assigned, hypothecated and transferred, and granted to the Agent, for itself and for the benefit of the Lenders, a continuing security interest in all of the Grantor's right, title and interest in certain collateral, including the Marks; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the purpose of this document to memorialize the aforementioned security interest in a form suitable for recordation in the United States Patent and Trademark Office;




