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## GENERAL ASSIGNMENT OF ASSETS

Leucadia, Inc., a New York corporation ("Assignor"), does hereby grant, bargain, convey, transfer and assign, as of February 1, 2005 (the "Effective Date"), unto Conwed Plastics LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Assignee"), its wholly owned subsidiary, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to those assets described on the exhibits attached hereto ("Conwed Assigned Assets"), whether real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, absolute or contingent, and wherever situated, as well as all liabilities, obligations and commitments relating to the Conwed Purchased Assets (the "Liabilities").

Assignor hereby agrees to assign to Assignee, and Assignee hereby agrees to accept from Assignor, under this General Asset Assignment ("Assignment"), the Patents, Marks, Tangible Personal Property and Leases (as defined below).

For and in consideration of all of the membership interest of Assignee, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby agrees to assign, and does hereby assign, the following:

1. Assignment. Assignor does hereby grant, bargain, convey, transfer, assign and set over to Assignee

(a) all of Assignor's rights, title and interests in, to and under the patents described on Exhibit A (the "Patents") and the inventions covered thereby, and divisionals, continuations-in-part (if any), continuations thereof (if any), extensions, refiles, renewals, substitutions, reexaminations and reissues thereof, together with all past, present, or future claims arising out of any infringement thereof, and all rights to claim priority on the basis of the Patents which may hereafter be filed for these Patents and/or the inventions covered thereby in any foreign country and all Letters Patent which may be granted on these Patents and/or the inventions covered thereby in any foreign country, and all divisionals, continuations-in-part (if any), continuations thereof (if any), extensions, refiles, renewals, substitutions, reexaminations and reissues thereof, all such rights to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives;

(b) all of Assignor's right, title and interest in, to and under the Trademark Registrations shown on the attached Exhibit B (the "Marks") and registrations, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Marks, together with all rights and privileges granted and secured thereby, including the right to sue and recover for any past infringement, said rights to be held and enjoyed by said Assignee, for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives;

(c) all machinery, equipment, tools, furniture, fixtures, equipment, inventory, computer hardware, supplies, materials, dies, jigs, molds, patterns, tools, leasehold improvements and construction-in-process, trucks, automobiles, other vehicles and transportation equipment, computing and telecommunications equipment and other items of tangible personal property, of every kind owned or leased by Assignor and used by

Assignee (wherever located and whether or not carried on Assignor's books), together with any express or implied warranty by the manufacturers or sellers or lessors of any item or component part thereof, and all maintenance records and other documents relating thereto (collectively, the "Tangible Personal Property"), and all manufacturers' and suppliers' warranties or guarantees with respect thereto, including, without limitation, the Tangible Personal Property, shown on the attached Exhibit C; and

(c) all of Assignor's right, title and interest in, to and under the leasehold interests in the real property leases shown on the attached Exhibit D (the "Leases"), provided, however, that nothing herein is intended to convey or transfer to Assignee the fee title interest to any real estate.

Assignor will hereafter execute and deliver such further assignments, instruments of transfer, bills of sale, certificates of title, powers of attorney or conveyances and perform such other acts, as may be necessary or desirable fully to vest in Assignee title to and enjoyment of the Conwed Assigned Assets.

2. Assumption. Assignee, for itself and its successors and assigns, hereby accepts the foregoing assignment and assumes and agrees to be bound by and to pay, perform, observe and discharge all of the covenants, agreements, duties, responsibilities and obligations of Assignor arising with respect to such Conwed Assigned Assets from and after the Effective Date of this Assignment.

3. No Representations and Warranties. The foregoing assignment is made without representations or warranty.


4. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which counterparts taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.
