PATENT AND TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, William L. Welch ("Assignor") is now the owner, by virtue of an assignment by Welch-Sluder IP Partners ("Welch-Sluder"), of U.S. Patent No. 5,165,651, entitled "Machine Foundation and Method for Preparing or Repairing a Machine Foundation;" U.S. Patent No. 5,437,430, entitled ""Method for Preparing or Repairing a Machine Foundation;" and U.S. Patent No. 5,611,974, entitled "Method for Preparing or Repairing a Machine Foundation" ("Patents"), which ownership gives Assignor the right to sue for and collect damages for past infringement, which right is acknowledged to continue past the expiration of each of the Patents;

WHEREAS, Assignor is also the owner, by virtue of an assignment by Welch-Sluder, of the trademark rights in the mark "POLYSHIELD" ("Mark"), together with the goodwill associated therewith, including but not limited to: (a) trademark rights defined by United States Trademark and Service Mark Registration No. 1,665,370, for "Pre-cast Polymer Machine Bases;" and "installing and repairing corrosion-resistant bases and foundations for machines" in connection with goods sold and services provided by Structural under license by Welch-Sluder; (b) trademark rights existing under the common law in the Mark for any use of the Mark made on or in connection with goods that have been sold or provided by Structural Group, Inc., formerly known as Structural Preservation Systems, LLC ("Structural") under license by Welch-Sluder; and (c) service mark rights existing under the common law in the Mark for any use of the Mark made in connection with services provided by Structural under license by Welch-Sluder; and

WHEREAS, Assignor desires to transfer all his ownership interests in the Patents and the Mark to William L. Welch, LLC, 11026 Wortham Blvd., Houston, Texas, 77065 (Assignee),

NOW, THEREFORE, for Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by Assignor to have been received in full from Assignee:

1. Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee his full, exclusive and undivided right, title and interest in and to the Patents, and agrees to execute any confirmatory assignments, declarations, or other documents in relation to such Patents;

2. **Assignor** hereby sells, assigns and transfers unto **Assignee**, its successors and assigns, **Assignor's** entire right, title and interest in and to the trademark rights in the Mark, together with the goodwill associated therewith that is and has been symbolized and associated with the Mark, including the aforementioned common law trademark rights and the rights in U.S. Registration No. 1,665,370, for "POLYSHIELD.

3. The term and covenants of this agreement shall inure to the benefit of said **Assignee**, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon the **Assignor**, his respective heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

4. **Assignor** hereby warrants and represents that he has not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.
