TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT -TRADEMARKS

This TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Agreement") in entered into this 11th day of October, 2011 by and between Wells Fargo & Company, a Delaware Corporation having an address of 420 Montgomery St., San Francisco, CA 94163 (hereinafter, "Assignee") and Southwall Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation having an address of 3788 Fabian Way, Palo Alto, CA 94303 (hereinafter "Assignor"), collectively the "Parties".

WHEREAS, Assignee is the successor in interest to the assets of Pacific Business Funding (hereinafter "PBF"), which was a division of Cupertino National Bank, and had an address of 20195 Stevens Creek Blvd., Suite 220, Cupertino, CA 95014.

WHEREAS, PBF and Assignor signed an agreement titled Intellectual Property Security Agreement which agreement was executed on June 30, 1999 and was filed with the US Patent and Trademark Office, Assignment Services Division at Reel: 002215 / Frame: 0339 et seq. A copy of the Intellectual Property Security Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Assignee is the successor of PBF to the Intellectual Property Security Agreement.

WHEREAS the Parties agree that Assignor has satisfied its obligations to Assignee under the terms of the Intellectual Property Security Agreement.

WHEREAS Assignee has agreed to terminate and release its security interest and all of its right, title and interest in each of the listed trademarks in Exhibit B in favor of Assignor.

NOW THEREFORE, the Assignee and Assignor agree as follows:

1. Release and Assignment. Assignee hereby releases and terminates it security interest in and lien on all of Assignor's named trademarks set forth in Exhibit B which security interest and lien was created by the Agreement titled Intellectual Property Security Agreement, dated June 30, 1999, and hereby assigns and transfers to the Assignor, without recourse, all of the Assignees rights, title and interest in and to each of the trademarks listed on Exhibit B effective as of the date set forth above.
2. Acknowledgement and Acceptance. Assignor hereby acknowledges and accepts the foregoing release and assignment by Assignee.

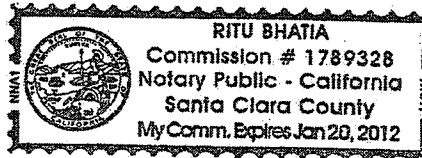

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

This Intellectual Property Security Agreement is entered into as of June 30, 1999 by and between PACIFIC BUSINESS FUNDING ("PBF") and SOUTHWALL TECHNOLOGIES INC. ("Grantor").

RECITALS

A. PBF has agreed to make certain advances of money and to extend certain financial accommodation to Grantor (the "Loans") in the amounts and manner set forth in that certain Receivables Financing Agreement by and between PBF and Grantor dated June 30, 1999 (as the same may be amended, modified or supplemented from time to time, the "Loan Agreement"; capitalized terms used herein are used as defined in the Loan Agreement). PBF is willing to make the Loans to Grantor, but only upon the condition, among others, that Grantor shall grant to PBF a security interest in certain Copyrights, Trademarks and Patents to secure the obligations of Grantor under the Loan Agreement.

B. Pursuant to the terms of the Loan Agreement, Grantor has granted to PBF a security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest, whether presently existing or hereafter acquired, in, to and under all of the Collateral.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, as collateral security for the prompt and complete payment when due of its obligations under the Loan Agreement, Grantor hereby represents, warrants, covenants and agrees as follows:

AGREEMENT

To secure its obligations under the Loan Agreement, Grantor grants and pledges to PBF a security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under all of its personal property, now existing or hereafter arising (including without limitation those Copyrights, Patents and Trademarks listed on Schedules A, B and C hereto), and including without limitation all proceeds thereof (such as, by way of example but not by way of limitation, license royalties and proceeds of infringement suits), the right to sue for past, present and future infringements, all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world and all reissues, divisions continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof.

This security interest is granted in conjunction with the security interest granted to PBF under the Loan Agreement. The rights and remedies of PBF with respect to the security interest granted hereby are in addition to those set forth in the Loan Agreement and the other Loan Documents, and those which are now or hereafter available to PBF as a matter of law or equity. Each right, power and remedy of PBF provided for herein or in the Loan Agreement of any of the Loan Documents, or now or hereafter existing at law or in equity shall be cumulative and concurrent and shall be in addition to every right, power or remedy provided for herein and the exercise by PBF of any one or more of the rights, powers or remedies provided for in this Intellectual Property Security Agreement, the Loan Agreement or any of the other Loan Documents, or now or hereafter existing at law or in equity, shall not preclude the simultaneous or later exercise by any person, including PBF, of any or all other rights, powers or remedies.
