CONVERSION APPLICATION OF CPI PROGRAMS, INC.

- 1. The name of the Converting Entity is CPI PROGRAMS, INC., a corporation organized and existing under the Louisiana Business Corporation law. The name of the Converted Entity will be CPI PROGRAMS, L.L.C.
- 2. The resulting Converted Entity will be a limited liability company governed by Louisiana Revised Statutes, Title 12, Chapter 22, section 1301, et seq.
