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**CERTIFICATE OF AMENDED AND RESTATED
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

Richard Cook and June M. Baldwin certify that:

1. They are the Chair of the Board and the Assistant Secretary, respectively, of KCETLink, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation.
2. The Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation are amended and restated to read in their entirety as follows:

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
PUBLIC MEDIA GROUP OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA**

I.

The name of the corporation is: Public Media Group of Southern California.

II.

A. The corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.

B. The specific purpose of the corporation is to be a vibrant public media organization that informs, educates and enlightens the public by delivering, across multiple platforms, noncommercial content it creates and curates from around the world. Additionally, the corporation may engage in any activities that are reasonably related to or in furtherance of its stated charitable and public purpose, or in any other charitable activities. Such charitable and public purposes include, but are not limited to, serving the public with programming and services in the areas of arts and culture; news and information; the environment; science, nature and technology; comedy and drama; children and families; and more.

C. The corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended (the "Code").

D. In furtherance of its purposes, the corporation shall have all the general powers enumerated in Sections 5140 and 5141 of the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended, together with the power to solicit grants and contributions for such purposes.

III.

The corporation shall have no members.

IV.

A. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise permitted by Section 501(h) of the Code and in any corresponding laws of the State of California), and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not directly or indirectly carry on any activity which would prevent it from obtaining exemption from Federal income taxation as a corporation described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or cause it to lose such exempt status, or carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

V.


The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes meeting the requirements for exemption provided by Section 214 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and no part of the net income or assets of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes meeting the requirements for exemption provided by Section 214 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

3. The foregoing amendment and restatement of the Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation has been duly approved by the Board of Directors of this Corporation.
4. The Corporation has no members.


