## Planting for Success

- 1) DIG HOLE. Two times width of pot.
- PREPARE SOIL. Combine planting mix and soil. Add a slow release starter fertilizer.
- SET PLANT. Place plant in hole so top of root ball is slightly above ground level.
- BACK FILL. Pack soil gently but firmly, and form a berry.
- WATER TO SETTLE. Add more soil as needed, water again,
- () FINISH, Add a 1/2" layer of mulch.

## Care Instructions

Provide enriched, well-drained soil that is moist but not soggy. Apply mulch to conserve moisture and protect in harsh winters. Water deeply, regularly in first growing season to establish extensive root system. Once established, water as needed to maintain evenly moist soil. Feed in early spring. Blooms on old wood; prune after flowering.
