Planting for Success

- DIG HOLE.** Two times width of pot.
- PREPARE SOIL.** Combine planting mix and soil. Add a slow release starter fertilizer.
- SET PLANT.** Place plant in hole so top of root ball is slightly above ground level.
- BACK FILL.** Pack soil gently but firmly, and form a berm.
- WATER TO SETTLE.** Add more soil as needed, water again.
- FINISH.** Add a 1/2" layer of mulch.

Care Instructions

Thrives in average, well-drained soils. Water deeply, regularly during first growing season to establish extensive root system. Feed before new growth begins in spring. Thin young trees in late winter to early spring, leaving 3 to 7 main trunks or canopy branches. Remove emerging suckers from base of older trees.

Monrovia plants are grown in our custom-blended, nutrient-rich soil, giving them a healthy start for your gardening success.
