FIELD Arts

We just wrapped up our first Unit for this school year with FIELD (Family Involvement in Early Literacy Development) Arts, an arts-integrated initiative in local at-risk Pre-K classrooms in partnership with Richmond CenterStage and the Latin Ballet of Virginia.

Working in 4 different local schools and 8 different classrooms, teaching artists from Virginia Rep and the Latin Ballet of Virginia teach 5 lessons each Unit in the classroom, accompanied with a related field trip.

In our first Unit this year, "The Five Senses," we use the story of *Goldilocks and the Three Bears* along with our "Performers Tool Kit: Voice, Body, Imagination, Cooperation, and Concentration" to act, sing, and dance our way through our five senses. In the middle of the Unit we took all 150 preschoolers and some of their parents to the Latin Ballet's production of *Verde* to experience a live performance and make connections to our work in the classroom.

We're gearing up for Unit 2, "Animals Everywhere," where we'll continue to use our "Tools" to learn about different animals in the home, on the farm, and in the wild. We even get to take a trip to the Maymont Nature Center to see some animals up close!
