


Mahoning Creek

The Mahoning Creek Hydroelectric Project is a 6.0 MW hydroelectric facility at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Mahoning Dam, which is located on Mahoning Creek in Armstrong County, Pennsylvania. The project includes the construction of a new powerhouse containing 4-MW and 2-MW vertical-shaft generating units. The project reached commercial operation in December 2013 and will annually produce more than 20,000 MWh, which is enough to provide clean electricity to over 1,800 homes for over 50 years.







Button Rock

The Button Rock Dam Hydroelectric Project is an early development stage 1.5 MW hydroelectric facility located at the Button Rock Dam near the town of Lyons, Boulder County, Colorado. The project includes the construction of a new powerhouse containing one 1.5 MW Francis turbine generating unit. The estimated annual generation of the Button Rock Dam Hydroelectric Project is 5,000 MWh, which is enough to provide clean electricity to over 450 homes for over 50 years.
