Consider ReliaFit instead of Urinary Catheters9:

- For patients without urinary retention or bladder outlet obstruction
- When strict or real-time measurement of UO not required
- For perioperative use
 - Non-urologic
 - Short duration
 - Large volume infusions or diuretics not administered
 - Intraoperative monitoring of UO is not required
- For incontinent patients with open sacral or perineal wounds
- For patients at increased risk of mortality associated w/ catheterization
- To improve comfort during end-of-life care
