- 1140% increase storm-water capture
- 445% increase in permeable surface
- 4 big-belly trash and recycle bins
- 1 water fountain
- 186% increase in fixed seating
 - Custom swivel chairs, under-lit benches and seasonal movable furniture
- 630% increase in lighting
 - Decorative lighting and custom moonlights, under-lit benches
