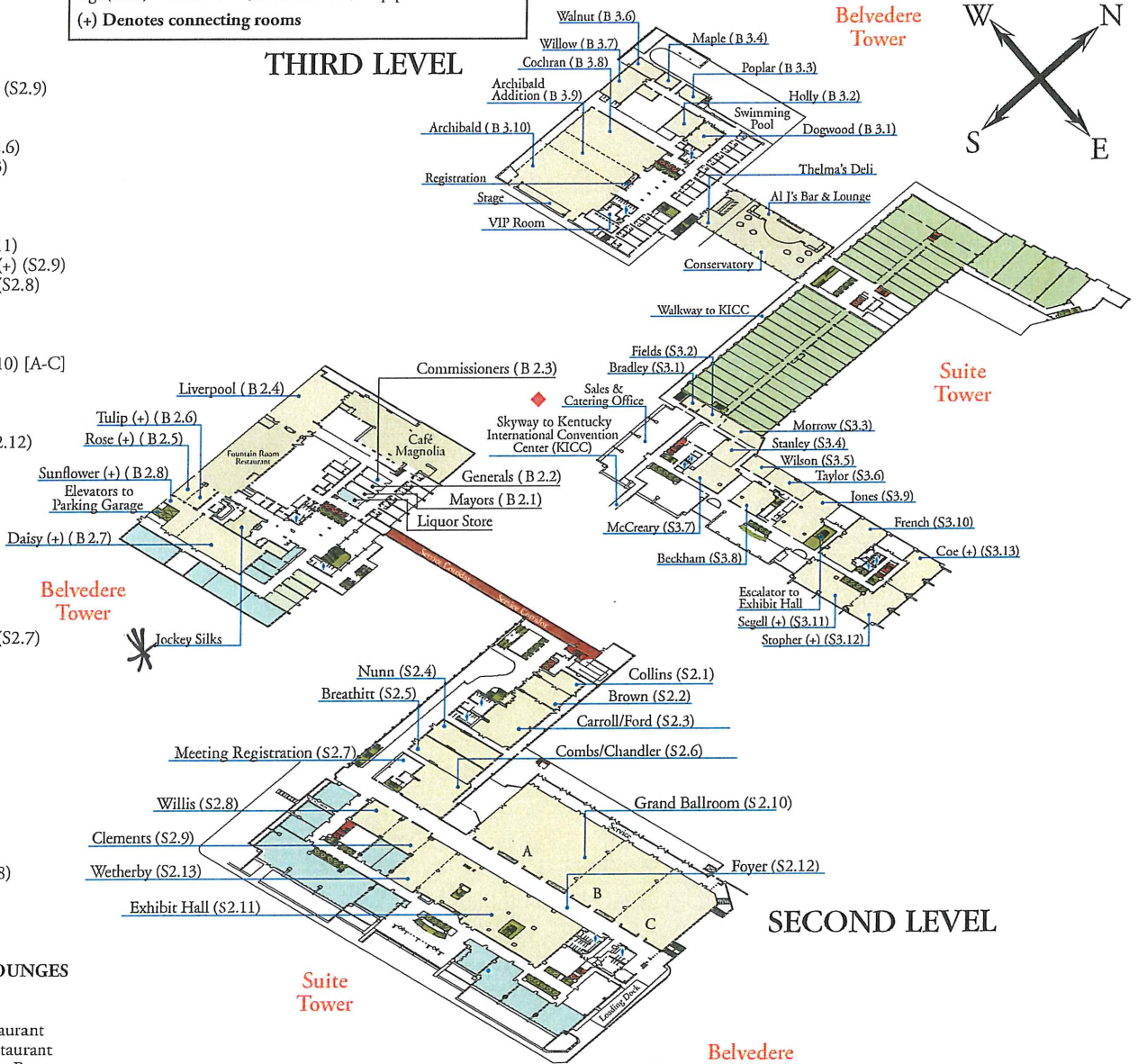

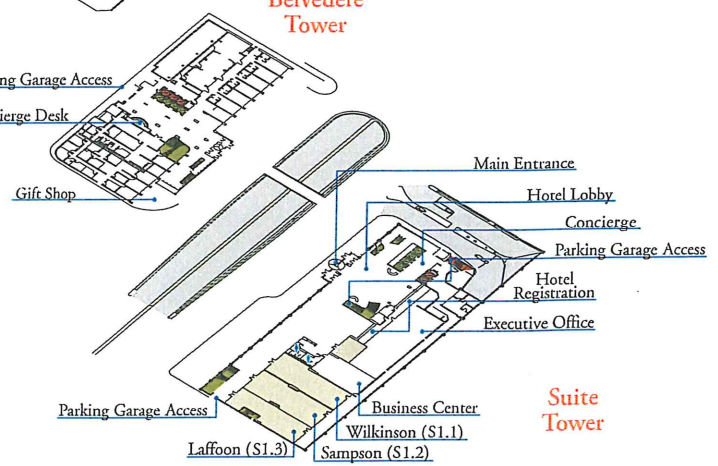

# THE HISTORY OF THE HOTEL

The first Galt House was actually the residence of Dr. William C. Galt and was located at Second and Main Streets. In the early 1800s Dr. Galt opened his home to paying guests who were visiting Louisville. The need was such that in 1835 Dr. Galt built a 60-room hotel on the opposite corner from his residence.

From these simple beginnings, the hotel set the standard for excellence in food and lodging. While touring America in 1842, Charles Dickens wrote, "We slept at the Galt House; a splendid hotel and were as handsomely lodged as though we had been in Paris..." Dicken's opinion was shared by many other notable guests, such as Jefferson Davis and Presidents Lincoln, Grant, Hayes and Buchanan. Sherman and Grant met here in March 1864 to plan the invasion that led to the "March to the Sea."

In 1865 the Galt House was destroyed by fire, but rapidly expanding Louisville was ready for the fabulous new Galt House Hotel which opened in 1869 at First and Main Streets. Heralded as the finest hotel in the South, Henry Whitestone's masterpiece was for fifty years the center of Louisville social life. In 1921 the structure was razed and for a half century only memories of the Galt House remained.

Louisville visionary Al J. Schneider built a magnificent twenty-five story hotel in 1972 on the river at Fourth Street and named it in honor of the city's first ambassador of hospitality and hotelier, Dr. Galt. In March 1985 Mr. Schneider added the East Tower with 600 suites featuring spacious living/dining area, wet bar, refrigerator, cable television and a separate bedroom. Today the Galt House Hotel & Suites has completed a \$60 million dollar renovation of both Towers and continues the grand legacy of southern hospitality and excellence.

The legacy of the Al J. Schneider Company continues under the direction and leadership of his daughters. In all, the Al J. Schneider Company owns and operates more than 2200 hotels rooms and 200,000 square feet of conference and convention space in the Louisville area, with \$100 million in sales. In addition to the Galt House, the company also owns and manages the Executive Inn and Executive West Hotels.

## AL J. SCHNEIDER 1914-2001 *A Louisville Visionary*

Al J. Schneider was a Louisville visionary who pioneered the transformation and



renaissance of the riverfront by building the city's largest hotel at the time—and the first new downtown hotel in 40 years—on Fourth Street at the river. Schneider also led the effort to open the riverfront to public access with construction of the city's Belvedere.

Schneider grew up as the hard-driving grandson of German immigrants who, at the age of 24 with an eighth grade education, started a lumber company with a \$500 loan. The outspoken, big-dreaming builder established a reputation as a man who did things rather than talked

about them. He has been recognized as the "savior of the Louisville waterfront," and credited with bringing more change and improvements to the city's appearance than anyone else in recent history.

His vision was exactly what Louisville needed. The *Courier-Journal* reported in 1969 that "(Schneider) made the only bid to develop the large hotel upon which depends the materialization of Louisville's dream of a riverfront gateway of plazas, view spots, people-places and living and office facilities."

The 700 room Galt House Belvedere Tower was built in 1972 and it was such a success that the Suite Tower was built across the street 12 years later, boasting 601 suites, more than any hotel outside of Las Vegas. The towers helped spur downtown development and convention business to new heights.

Throughout his life, Mr. Schneider demonstrated his philanthropy and profound belief in supporting education by reaching out to those in greatest need. His legacy is greater than the Al J. Schneider Company as his foundation continues to benefit the community.

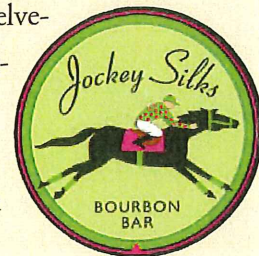
