

# Construction begins on Arrington Road project

**BRAZOS COUNTY, Tex. (KBTX)** - A major construction project begins in South Brazos County Monday.

A portion of Arrington Rd. between Old Arrington Rd. and Mesa Verde will be closed to through traffic for the next five months.

County officials say only residents, mail, trash and emergency services will have access to the road.

All other access to Indian Lakes, Nantucket, and South Oaks will have to come from Hwy 6.

The construction project will widen the road, add a new pavement cross-section and culverts with headwalls.
