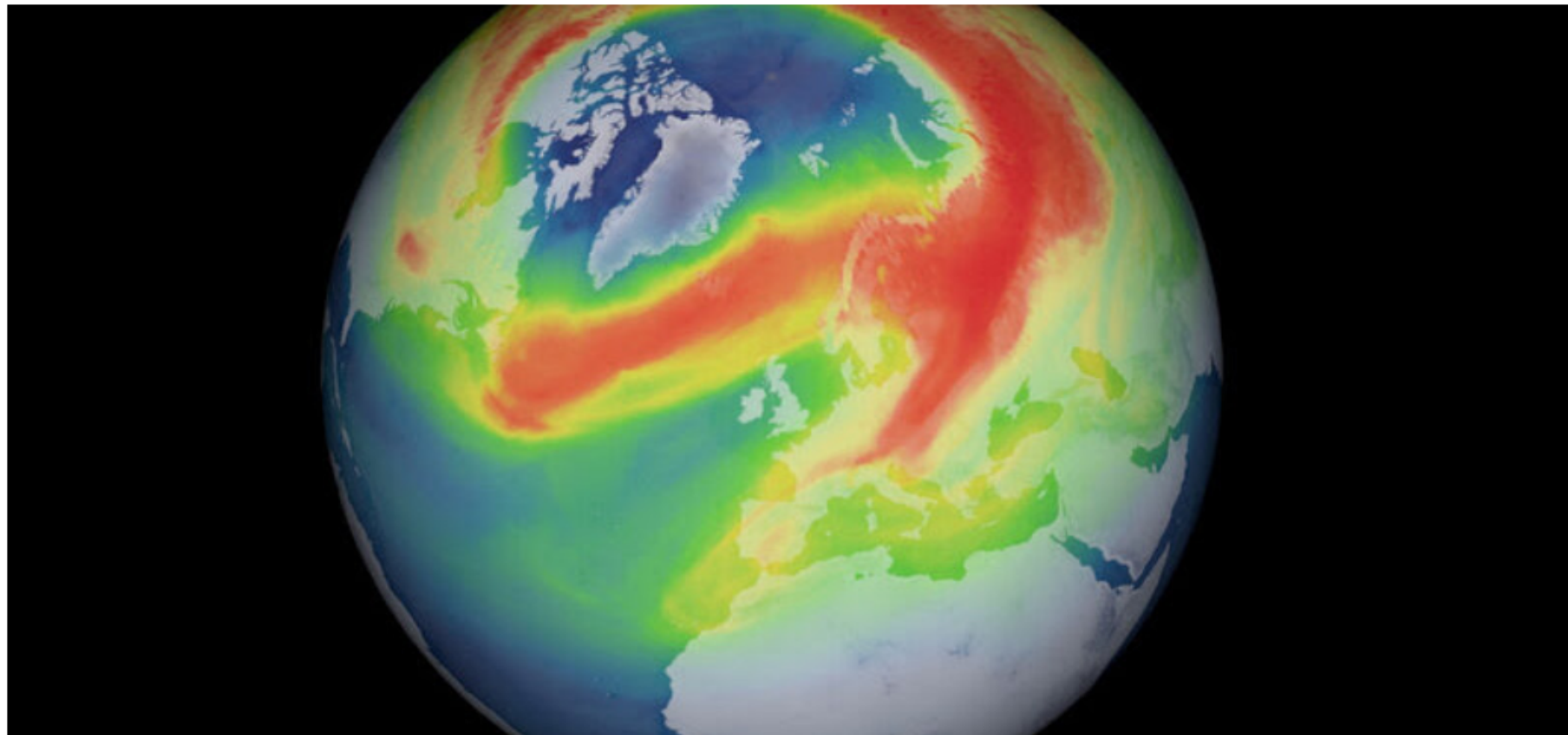


A rare ozone hole is open over the Arctic
