

## Form 16SF and 1107SF Reporting

Coming November 2020: The Unified Counterparty Experience System® (UCount<sup>SM</sup>) will replace Form 16SF, Annual Eligibility Certification Report and Form 1107SF, Seller/Servicer Change Notification Form. ## **Current Reporting Requirements**

As an approved Freddie Mac Seller/Servicer, each year your organization must submit the *Annual Eligibility Certification Report* (Form 16SF). When there are institutional changes to your organization that haven't already been reported on Form 16SF, then you also need to submit the *Seller/Servicer Change Notification Form* (Form 1107SF).

There are two options to gain access to these forms:

- Freddie Mac Access Manager Our self-service platform for accessing and using Freddie Mac tools and applications enables you to manage your own access credentials.

Please note: If you are logging into Access Manager for the first time, you will need to change your password.
