

Trademark/Service Mark Application Principal Register



MARK:

The literal element of the mark consists of STS. The design consists of STS appearing within a shield.

The applicant, Scantron Corporation, a Delaware corporation having an address of 1313 Lone Oak Road, Eagan, MN 55121, United States, requests registration of the trademark/service mark identified above in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on the Principal Register established by the Act of July 5, 1946 (15 U.S.C. Section 1051 et seq.), as amended, for the following:

International Class 42: *computer services, namely, online scanning, detecting, quarantining and eliminating of viruses, worms, trojans, spyware, adware, malware and unauthorized data and programs on computers and electronic devices; platform as a service (PaaS) featuring computer software platforms for use in database management; computer project management services; technical consulting services in the field of computer hardware and software support; telecommunications technology consultancy; information technology [IT] consulting services; computer network design for others; technical support services, namely, 24/7 monitoring of network systems, servers and web and database applications and notification of related events and alerts; technical support, namely, monitoring technological functions of computer network systems; professional computer services, namely, network analysis, LAN/WAN design, wireless engineering, virtualization and computer project management; computer security service, namely, restricting access to and by computer networks to and of undesired web sites, media and individuals and facilities; providing a secured-access website that gives registered internet networked institutions the ability to upload, view, copy, print, download and share documents and images for the purposes of conducting consumer-driven transactions; computer security services, namely, restricting unauthorized access to computer networks; computer security consultancy in the field of scanning and penetration testing of computers and networks to assess information security vulnerability; design, development and implementation of software; technology consultation in the field of cybersecurity; technical support, namely, providing backup computer programs and facilities; backup services for computer hard drive data; recovery of computer data; computer disaster recovery planning; computer technology support services, namely, help desk services; electronic storage of documents and archived e-mails; developing and hosting a server on a global computer network for the purpose of facilitating e-commerce via such a server; server hosting; infrastructure as a service (IaaS) services, namely, hosting servers for use by others; online web site that enables the management of print systems of others by providing technical maintenance and performance reports based on data provided by users*

The applicant has a bona fide intention, and is entitled, to use the mark in commerce on or in connection with the identified services.

A fee payment in the amount of \$1,050 will be submitted with the application, representing payment for 3 class(es).
