# How to sign in to Robinhood from a new device

Got a new phone or tablet? We'll walk you through how to set things up so you're ready to go.

To figure out how to sign in to your Robinhood account on a new device, you'll need to follow directions depending on whether you had [Two-Factor Authentication \(2FA\)](#) enabled on your old device, if you still have your old device, and whether you still have your Backup Code.
