


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


The Present Crisis of PreK-8 Religious Education

- For the last 100 years, four companies have dominated the Prek-8 marketplace with over 90% market share. During this time, over 8,000 Catholic schools closed despite the Catholic population growing by over 25M.
- There is a great need for curricula to provide comprehensive family catechesis, evangelizing and catechizing both the parents and children.³
- Deeply formed religious sisters have given way to over 150K lay volunteer catechists who often need effective and ongoing formation to communicate the faith effectively.
- Millions of parents have not been evangelized and catechized; therefore, they rely on the parish and Catholic schools to teach the faith.
- Word of Life not only provides faithful teaching, it goes beyond to explain why the faith is relevant in our modern culture. A Loss of Catholic Identity and Mission
