Leading the Charge for Electric Vehicles

BGE's EVsmart Program gives customers the tools and incentives they need to charge their electric vehicle (EV) faster and more conveniently than ever before. Through the EVsmart online toolkit, customers can apply for a smart charger rebate, learn the basics of EV charging and use savings calculators to compare the cost of gas-powered versus electric-powered vehicles.

BGE residential customers who install select Level 2 smart chargers may be eligible for a \$300 rebate. A Level 2 smart charger allows EV owners to charge their vehicle significantly faster than with a standard Level 1 charger and lets them track their energy usage with a smartphone app. Multifamily property managers and owners can also receive up to \$25,000 in incentives for the installation of Level 2 or DC Fast Chargers at their property.
