PRACTICAL AUTOMOTIVE SKILLS

Students receive intensive instruction in automotive theory, as well as practical skills. Technical skills are taught in the classroom in both large and small group formats. CRITICAL LIFE SKILLS



Students are given personalized attention as they develop vital interpersonal, professional and life management techniques to last a lifetime.

Life Skills classes are taught twice a week and are designed to help students understand how to handle real-life situations, become familiar with current events and better comprehend issues in society and politics. Class topics include subjects such as job interview skills, resume writing, setting and achieving goals and health and personal wellness. Field trips, guest speakers and team-building activities enrich the student experience.

FOUNDATIONAL ACADEMIC SKILLS



Professional instructors and caring tutors give students the individualized guidance they need to grow their academic skills to the next level. Test preparation and tailored support are offered to help students achieve their high school diplomas or specialized mechanical certifications.

This individualized element of the YATC curriculum helps students improve academic knowledge based on each student's needs. Curriculums are designed by YATC's two academic instructors to specifically target each student's areas for improvement based on their performance on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE).
