



Certified Business Analysis Specialist - Banking

Business Analysts plays key role in IT application development. As a change agent, a business analyst is responsible for gathering and documenting business requirements, defining functional specification, creating wireframes and process models, help the application development team understand the business context for the requirements and clarify any questions the development team may have. A good banking business analyst is expected to have a strong understanding of banking domain.

Skill Board Certified Business Analysis Specialist - Banking evaluates candidates for understanding of Requirements elicitation, Analysis and Requirements documentation process. Candidates are also evaluated for fundamental knowledge of core banking, cards & payments, lending and financial crime compliance and skills develop solutions for business problems in operations and technology that enables banking and financial services firms to deliver services to clients. The assessment is conducted through an online remote proctored test.

Certified Business Analysis Specialist (CBAS) - Banking certification is issued to candidates who successfully pass the combined assessment for business analysis process knowledge, process modeling knowledge, basic IT skills and banking & financial services Industry domain knowledge.

- Knowledge of business analysis processes and visual modeling.
- Knowledge of basic information technology concepts and business analysis tools.
- Knowledge of banking systems and business processes
