Ozonated Rizole Oils

Mixed with water, ozonides produce emulsions that can be taken internally. They are popularly used in alternative medicine as a treatment of some Lyme patients. They were already being used clinically between 1915 and 1947 in the U.S., for example, against wound infection in operations and against fungi, bacteria, and viruses in both humans and animals. They have not been widely used since 1947 because antibiotics from fungus cells and synthetic biocides became available in large quantities.
