Dear Brandon Lee Kilpatrick:

By order of the Washington Supreme Court, you are admitted to limited practice in the State of Washington, effective 6/5/2018. However, you may not act as a Licensed Legal Intern until the date your supervisor agreed to begin supervising you as indicated in the supervising lawyer's declaration included in your application. (If the supervision start date listed is before the license date, the license is <u>not</u> retroactive.)

Your supervising attorney, Leah S Snyder, has agreed to supervise you until 10/1/2018, at which time the supervisor will be relieved of the responsibilities as your supervisor. If your supervisor has not agreed to supervise you until your license expires on 12/5/2020, you must file a completed Change of Supervising Lawyer form with the WSBA advising us who your supervisor will be for the remainder of your term as a Licensed Legal Intern in order to continue your legal intern status. The supervision change form is available on the WSBA website at: http://www.wsba.org/rule9.

It is your obligation to familiarize yourself with the obligations and restrictions contained in APR 9. You should be aware, for example, that you must cease to function as a Rule 9 Licensed Legal Intern prior to the expiration date on the court order, and the enclosed identification card, for any of the possible causes set forth in APR 9(h), such as loss of an approved supervisor or loss of good academic standing prior to graduation. You should also be aware that under APR 9(h) no legal intern license is valid more than 18 months after graduation from law school.

Enclosed is your Licensed Legal Intern identification card.
