

WINC PROVIDES TRAINING & EDUCATION TO WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS

WINC offers a time and place for women to support each other in doing what we love, improving the way we run our businesses, and discovering meaningful community and self-awareness.

In September 2012, WINC will bring together twelve women business owners in Boulder, Colorado. These twelve women will spend one year together in regular meetings to vision, plan, and execute the next layer of their businesses in a culture of cooperation and accountability.

The circle of twelve women will be a rich source of inspiration and an essential resource for each other's personal and professional growth.

Myka McLaughlin, the founder of WINC, will facilitate these bi-weekly meetings to:

- Cultivate genuine intimacy;
- Provide training on business development, business planning, and business operations; and
- Emphasize getting real work done during each meeting.

In February 2012, WINC will accept applications for a trial run of its first group of women entrepreneurs in Boulder, Colorado. Please see below for more details.


ABOUT WINC TRIAL RUN

The WINC Trial Run provides a means to test the WINC model for bringing together women entrepreneurs in regular meetings to envision their business, develop a plan, and execute their life's vision. The regular meetings will be facilitated by the founder of WINC, Myka McLaughlin, and will focus on four themes described below.



CONNECTION

Each meeting will provide a time to connect with the other selfemployed women through a check-in format, allowing us to share the highs and lows of running our businesses. The women in the circle will become resources to each other – each bringing their own skill set and insight – while also providing a genuine community for women entrepreneurs to turn to for friendship and council.



VISION

The first four meetings will focus on developing a vision for our businesses. Through a variety of inspiring business resources and exercises, each meeting will provide tools and time to dream about how we want to live our lives and businesses. The vision process will generate new clarity for each woman about how to plan the next layer of her business.



PLAN

The last four meetings will focus on developing a plan for our businesses. Having identified our big-picture vision and goals for the amount of time we want to work, the revenue we need to generate, and the lifestyle we want to live, we can set about creating a plan to bring this vision to life. In this phase, we will focus on finances and marketing, two areas many self-employed women struggle with.



EXECUTE

Each meeting will provide a significant amount of time to actually get things done. With computers and notebooks in hand, we will execute tasks discussed in each meeting. For example, we will spend time writing our biography and then workshop it with partners. In this way, after each meeting we will feel a sense of accomplishment, and delight in the energy moving forward to make our vision real.


- Attend an info session on the WINC trial run on January 19 from 6-8pm or February 5 from 3-5pm to see if this is a fit for you.
