Use:

Marble is a porous, heat resistant rock that is great for chilling to keep food cool when being displayed for a party, event, or a relaxing evening. Place the marble board in the fridge until chilled, then remove and prepare your luxurious display. Chilling your marble board is also helpful for keeping dough from sticking, especially when you are trying not to add extra flour.

We **do not** recommend using marble as a cutting board as it will dull your knives, it may also damage the marble board. We **do** recommend using the marble board as a centerpiece to display food or set items such as candles and other home décor to extenuate your rooms ambiance.

- · Chill marble board in fridge to keep displayed foods chilled
- · Chill to use for baking and have stick free surface
- · Not recommended to use as a cutting board

After use:

Your marble board should be scrubbed with a light detergent soap with hot water and then immediately wiped dry. Another great alternative to keep your marble board clean is baking soda and water. Sprinkle a small amount of baking soda onto the surface of the marble and gently rub the baking soda with a soft cloth into the marble. Rinse with water and dry with a soft towel. Scrubbing is not recommended as it may damage the marble's surface.
