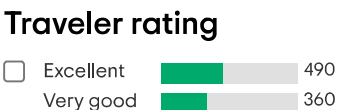

Lots of great wine, large pours, big glasses

At first glance you would assume a big restaurant, prime location in a tourist area would be touristy. It also attracts lots of locals even on off nights. The secret is probably the wine list. Huge. Pours at the bar are probably about 6 ounces. They have high end wines at high end prices but also interesting wines at about \$ 6.50 a glass. As a French wine fan I was really surprised with a Merlot produced at a New Jersey winery just outside town. It was one of the \$ 6.50 wines too.

The food has innovative touches that bring you back. The coconut bread is great! They have an iced tea infused with honey and mint too.

The menus can be confusing - There's a bar area (with it's own menu), a wine cellar (with a tapas menu), the restaurant (with the main menu and sunset menu as I recall.) If you want a burger you need to be in the right place or see if it can be arranged. Service is very friendly. For a wine fan it keeps you coming back.
