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HELP: One of the most popular and widely-used curriculum-based assessments

About HELP Online

HELP® 0-3 (the Hawaii early Learning Profile®), and HELP® 3-6 are among the most popular, widely-used, family-centered, curriculum-based assessments (CBA) for use by professionals working with infants, toddlers, young children, and their families: As curriculum-based assessments, HELP is used for identifying needs, tracking growth and development, and determining “next steps” (target objectives). It offers play-based activities and intervention strategies for each behavior/skill.

HELP is comprehensive and promotes a cross-disciplinary, integrated approach. HELP 3-6 skills extend HELP 0-3 skills to form a single continuum of over 1,200 skills (0-6 years) across 68 developmentally-sequenced “Strands” (rows on the Grid).

HELP focuses on the whole child, covering the six domains of development and emphasizing the importance of supportive environments and interactions, building on strengths and providing activities for working on specific needs.

Each HELP skill has a unique ID number (e.g., 1.01) for easy cross-reference across all the HELP content.

HELP Online (0-3) content includes *Inside HELP*, the *HELP Strands*, and *HELP at Home* authored by Stephanie Parks Warsaw.

HELP Online (3-6) content includes the entire series of HELP 3-6 (2nd Edition) materials adapted/edited by Teaford, Baker, et al.

HELP Online is built on the Kontinuums platform developed by SurfWax, Inc.
