

After my skin cancer patients died, I became a witness for the United States federal investigations; they knew my patients were specifically targeted for harm, and I

Dr. Johnathan Hung performed the mandated fitness for duty exam and prevented Dr. Liegeois from having the falsified "evidence." Dr. Hung concluded Dr. Liegeois was "unfit."
