#### **N7 INITIATIVE NEWS**



The N7 Conference on Agriculture, Water & Food Security convened experts, government officials, and other policymakers from all N7 countries, the U.S., Indonesia, Tunisia, and Burkina Faso, including for the first time, Palestinian participation.

From March 14 to 16, 2023, the N7 Initiative, a partnership between the Atlantic Council and Jeffrey M. Talpins Foundation, hosted the N7 Conference on Agriculture, Water, and Food Security in Abu Dhabi, with the support of the government of the United Arab Emirates. The conference took place during a time of serious tension in the region, but was still successful in bringing together more than 80 participants from a dozen countries, including all N7 countries plus

Indonesia, Tunisia, Burkina Faso, and for the first time, included Palestinian participation.

"Based on the extremely positive feedback we have received from officials responsible for the Negev Forum, the N7 Initiative has proven itself as a strong partner to the governments engaged in that effort," said Amb. Daniel B. Shapiro, director of the N7 Initiative. **Oren Eisner, President of the Jeffrey M. Talpins Foundation** affirmed, "Our goal is to produce innovative solutions to the shared regional challenges of food security, water scarcity and climate change."

This positive feedback has been recognized by government leaders throughout the region and in the United States. The N7 Conference featured remarks from former UK Prime Minister Tony Blair, Co-Chairs of the Senate Abraham Accords Caucus, Senator Cory Booker (D-NJ) and Senator Joni Ernst (R-IA), House Foreign Affairs Committee Chairman Representative Michael McCaul (R-TX), Co-Chair of the House Abraham Accords Caucus Representative Brad Schneider (D-IL), Principal Deputy Secretary of State for Near Eastern Affairs Yael Lempert, Israeli National Security Advisor Tzachi Hanegbi, Director of Policy Planning Department at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the UAE Abdulrahman Al Neyadi, Permanent Representative of the UAE to the International Renewable Energy Agency H.E. Nawal Al-Hosany, Israeli Ambassador to the UAE Amir Hayek, US Ambassador to Israel Thomas R. Nides, and Head of the Food System Initiative for COP28 Kristofer Hamel.

Writing for the Atlantic Council's New Atlanticist publication, Amb. Shapiro emphasized the importance of such initiatives, underscoring that "at a time when many official exchanges seem stalled or are moving slowly, these kinds of exchanges can have outsized value in finding areas of shared interest and forging common bonds." Amb. Shapiro made media rounds in Abu Dhabi with primetime interviews on <u>Connect the World with Becky Anderson</u> on CNN International and <u>i24 News</u> <u>English</u> in Tel Aviv. The work of the N7 Conference was also featured on the front pages of <u>FoxNews Digital</u>, <u>DW News English</u> and <u>Arabic</u>, and <u>The Times of</u> Israel.

This conference builds on the work of the N7 Conference on Education and Coexistence held last December in Rabat, with the support of the Kingdom of Morocco. Actionable policy recommendations from the first N7 Conference were shared with the Negev Forum Working Groups that met in Abu Dhabi in January 2023.

General El Mostafa Rabii to discuss the <u>expansion of the Abraham Accords</u> to include shared cybersecurity priorities and enhancing regional cooperation.

"The expansion of the Abraham Accords into cybersecurity is advancing our defensive operational collaboration with Israel and our partners across the Middle East to protect our critical infrastructure," said <a href="Under Secretary Silvers">Under Secretary Silvers</a>. "Together we can harness our capabilities to address the most pressing cybersecurity challenges to drive security and resilience."

The N7 Initiative will host a hybrid event on **April 17**, **2023** to explore the regional benefits of this expansion.




## Saudi Arabia Offers Its Price to Normalize Relations With Israel.

program, and fewer restrictions on US arms as its price for normalizing relations with Israel.

# Sudan and Israel agree to normalize diplomatic relations, implementation deferred.

REUTERS REPORTED: Israel and Sudan have finalized a deal to normalize relations, with a signing ceremony expected following a transfer of power from the military to a civilian government in Khartoum, the Israeli foreign ministry said ... Sudan's foreign ministry said earlier the deal was agreed upon during a visit by Israeli Foreign Minister Eli Cohen to "move towards normalizing relations between the two countries."

## Azerbaijan becomes first Shi'ite country to open embassy in Israel.

JNS REPORTED: Israeli Foreign Minister Eli Cohen welcomed Azerbaijani
Foreign Minister Jeyhun Bayramov to Jerusalem ahead of the inauguration of
the Azerbaijani embassy in Jerusalem. H.E. Mukhtar Mammadov was appointed
Azerbaijan's first ambassador to Israel in January 2023 amid escalating tensions
with Iran. Azerbaijan now becomes the first Shi'ite Muslim country to open an
embassy in Israel. Azerbaijan's parliament approved the establishment of the
embassy in Tel Aviv last November, but the two countries have enjoyed a decadeslong relationship prior to the establishment of official diplomatic relations. This
move represents an important step toward increased regional cooperation and
engagement, particularly in countering Iranian threats.

On the impact of new diplomatic relations, Amb. Daniel B. Shapiro said, "Israel's relations with Muslim nations continue to expand. Israel has long had relations with Azerbaijan and an embassy in Baku, but Azerbaijan will, for the first time, open an embassy in Israel. It's another sign of the taboo against relations with Israel coming

down, as nations of the region internalize the security and economic benefits that derive from an open partnership with Israel."




