Example 1: Distinguish requirements for a staff with different licensing and certification issues.

- RED & blank – required based on Job Title and needs attention (Figure 2).
- RED & non-blank – required based on Job Title, expired and needs attention
- GRAY – not required based on Job Title.
- WHITE – in compliance.

Example 2: A license driven by an expire date:

- The DEA License is required for MD’s and PA’s. In Figure 1, the license for Pam Marvel MD is YELLOW – it is within 90 days of expiring (see Figure 1).
- The DEA License for Bruce Davis PA is RED – it has expired (Figure 1).

Example 3: Track an organization-wide training. (The training feature is controlled by a single training date in a separate “Date Table”.)

- A yearly OSHA training was held on June 30, 2004.
 - The “OSHA Refresher Training” cells for non-medical employees are GRAY (Fig 1).
 - All medical employees are in compliance and their cells are WHITE (Fig 1).
- A new training is held on June 29, 2005. This date was entered into the “Date Table”.
 - Again, the cells for all non-medical employees are GRAY (Fig 2 below).
 - Employees Ellis, Hunter and Pearson took the new training, signed the training certificate issued to them by the instructor and submitted the signed certificate to the HR assistant on 7/1/05, 6/30/05 and 7/12/05 respectively. Their cells are WHITE (Fig 2).
 - Employees Davis & Marvel did not take the new training or have not turned in their signed certificates, therefore, their cells turned RED (Fig 2).

LONG-TERM RESERVE PROFILE

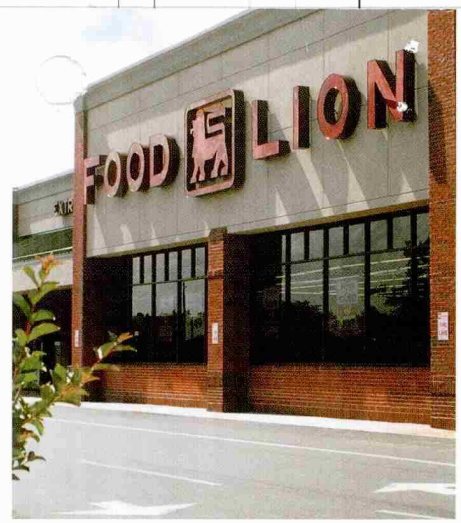
