

Applicant anticipates the possibility of a Solely Ornamental rejection based on the specimen submitted. Consequently, applicant has also included other specimens showing the mark as used in commerce as a means of showing that the mark also serves a source-indicating function. As stated at TMEP 1202.03(c), “the applicant may show: . . . (2) non-ornamental use of the mark in commerce on other goods or services . . .” as a means of overcoming a Solely Ornamental rejection. In view of the evidence submitted, applicant believes any such rejection would be incorrect.
