

RESPONSE TO OFFICE ACTION

Applicant, Uniboard Canada, Inc., hereby responds to the Office action mailed August 20, 2012.

AMENDMENT OF IDENTIFICATION OF GOODS

Further to the prior telephone discussion between Applicant's counsel Roger P. Furey and Trademark Examining Attorney Mr. Jim Ringle on October 3, 2012 about amending the identification of goods, Applicant hereby deletes the identification of goods in their entirety and replaces them with the following: BUILDING MATERIALS, NAMELY, MEDIUM DENSITY FIBERBOARD, NOT FOR USE WITH FLOORING OR CERAMIC TILES in International Class 19.

TRANSLATION

The English translation of "NATURA" in the mark is "nature; wildlife."

PRIORITY REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT

The foreign application that is the Section 44(d) basis for the application has not yet issued. Applicant therefore respectfully requests that the application be suspended until a copy of the foreign registration is available.

CONCLUSION

The goods in the Application, as amended, and the goods in the cited registrations are not similar. Applicant therefore respectfully requests that the refusal to register based on likelihood of confusion be withdrawn. This Application requires no further attention, except a copy of the foreign registration once available.
