



## Topcon announces MAGNET Enterprise, Field, and Office updates - v1.2.1

LIVERMORE, Calif. –Friday, February 22, 2013

Topcon Positioning Group announces updates to the MAGNET suite of productivity software products through new versions of MAGNET Field and MAGNET Office – v1.2.1.

MAGNET Enterprise is a cloud service that connects the Field and Office products and provides a web-based interface to company data. MAGNET Field is software that runs on field controllers and onboard total stations, and MAGNET Office is stand-alone office software for processing and modeling. MAGNET makes it possible for real-time collaboration between project manager, field crews, office personnel, engineers, or consultants.

Updates to MAGNET Enterprise include:

- Added a notification message to inform users of soon-to-expire and expired subscriptions when logging in.
- AutoCAD WS widget added (requires an AutoCAD WS account, and credentials to be entered into Data Manager).
- Subscription Manager upgraded to support renewals.

Updates to MAGNET Field include:

- Coordinate Systems: Geoid FIN2005N00 is now supported.
- Monitoring routine in onboard station software is now operational.
- Corrected an issue that prevented some surfaces from importing from DXF and DWG files.
- Corrected an issue so the onboard software will now display the initial "turn to" values in stakeout.
- Corrected an issue that caused the "Instrument is not responding" message to be shown in Backsight and Set collection routines.
- Corrected an issue that showed the activation screen in the routines when GIS mode was activated.

MAGNET Field Site users: It is recommended that customers back up the configurations and data. Then completely remove the existing installation and then install version 1.2.1.

Updates to MAGNET Office include:

- Corrected an issue that prevented users from activating to their USB keys.
- Import LandXML now reads polylines (imported as string).
- Implemented updates to GeoCalculator.
- Create Road and Create DTM are now available in Manual Road entry.
