# Juliet (Ausjameson)

'Juliet' has an unusually sophisticated colour that was not found in roses of old and is quite exceptional, even amongst modern cut roses. Pale peach buds gradually open to reveal many petals, neatly arranged in folds within the heart of the bloom. The inner petals are a deeper, contrasting shade of peach.

The large flower heads have the form of beautiful, cupped rosettes and are held elegantly upright on strong stems. This was one of the first David Austin cut roses to be released and it remains one of our best-known and most popular varieties. The alluring shade of peach will combine well with other colours, creating a feeling of warmth and romance. There is a very light tea rose fragrance.
