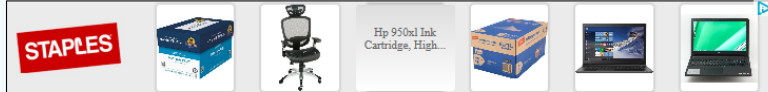


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

Definition of *fusion* in English:
noun

- 1 The process or result of joining two or more things together to form a single entity:
'a fusion of an idea from anthropology and an idea from psychology'
'malformation or fusion of the three bones in the middle ear'

- 1.1 *Physics* short for **nuclear fusion**.

- 1.2 The process of causing a material or object to melt with intense heat, especially so as to join with another:
