## Definition of *slay*

*transitive verb*

**1** : to kill violently, wantonly, or in great numbers

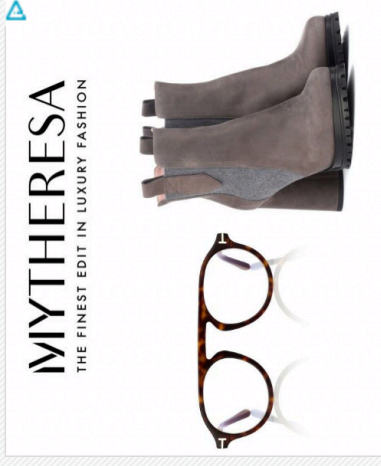
*broadly* : to strike down : **KILL**

**2** : to delight or amuse immensely

*//* *slayed* the audience

*intransitive verb*

: **KILL, MURDER**
