- *Point of purchase*, used often in retail
- *Proof-of-payment*, a fare collection approach
- Proof of principle in product development; see *proof of concept*

- "pop" operation on a *stack* (abstract data type) in computer science

- [Package on package](#), a circuit packaging technique
- [Point of presence](#), a demarcation point between communications entities
- [Post Office Protocol](#), an Internet e-mail protocol, the current version of which is POP3
