LibertyLink (gene)

LibertyLink is a BASF owned brand of <u>genes</u> for use in agriculture providing tolerance to <u>Liberty herbicide</u> and <u>glufosinate</u> (a.k.a. Liberty or Basta). The genes were developed by <u>Bayer CropScience</u>, before being sold to BASF Ag in late 2017. LibertyLink provides an herbicide resistance system that is still effective in the presence of glyphosate resistant <u>weeds</u>. ^[1] The gene which gives resistance to <u>glufosinate</u> is a bar or pat gene which was first isolated from two species of <u>Streptomyces</u> <u>bacteria</u>. Glufosinate was included in a <u>biocide</u> ban proposed by the Swedish Chemicals Agency^[2] and approved by the European Parliament on January 13, 2009. ^[3]

Crops

The LibertyLink gene is available in a variety of crops including corn, cotton, canola, sugarbeet and soybean. It is not available in rice. [4][5]
