Se the attached.

1. Order form for Soil Mechanix. Customer has the ability to have a full physical properties exam performed.
2. Shipping box
3. Shipping Box with cores and core puller. The core gets hammered into the ground and then the handle be inside the box (not shown). You will remove the metal cap and put rubber caps on both ends of core
4. Next pictures show core, metal cap and handle + extension handle for greater than 4." With the screw-
5. Form will be filled out and mailed with box. The Lab will get an emailed copy of the form from Distributor arrival. (Speed up the process).
6. Your initial shipment will be 10 cases. You will receive 10 boxes with a total of 20 cores. (2 per box). You will receive extension pullers, and tape. You will retain the metal caps, pullers and extension pullers for repeated use. They are made from aviation grade aluminum so they should last a long time.
7. You will place metal cap into core and tape the joint. Hammer into ground. Attach puller and pull core paper form instructing Lab what to do. Seal and ship. Email Lab a copy of form.
