Historical

- Allied was founded in 1928 as the radio parts distribution arm of Columbia Radio Corporation.
- In 1999, Allied became the North American division of Electrocomponents plc, a U.K. company, and a recognized leader in sales of electronic components
- In 2016, Allied expanded into South America, with a full-service office in Santiago, Chile.
- In 2017, we expanded our sales presence throughout Mexico.
- In 2018, we broke ground on a 220,000-square-foot, state-of-the-art warehouse addition, which is scheduled to open in mid-2020. It will provide an additional 500,000 stocked products, up from 170,000 today.

- Allied Electronics & Automation is the second largest operating company within Electrocomponents, the global distributor for engineers headquartered in London, England.
- Allied employs more than 900 people throughout the entire organization, which includes corporate headquarters, a warehouse, and distribution center in Fort Worth, Texas, and more than 40 sales offices.
- We service customers throughout the Americas, including the U.S., Canada, Chile, and Mexico.
- Our product portfolio includes more than 300 name-brand suppliers.
- Allied distributes a wide spectrum of product technologies, including automation & control, electromechanical, enclosures & fans, interconnect, passive & active, power, test & measurement, wire & cable, and more.

- Our website lists more than three million products, with online sales contributing approximately 42% to our total business. www.alliedelec.com.
- We ship more than 6,250 parcels per day, some within hours of receiving the order, from our 300,000-square-foot warehouse and distribution center.
- Customers can order up to 10 p.m. ET, and orders ship same day.
- Order up to 8 p.m. ET for next day delivery.
- We also schedule orders to ship when customers need them.
- Our warehouse, stocked with more than \$100 million worth of inventory, has more than 170,000 products on-hand every day.
- We use RF technology for paperless pick and put-away processes.
- We boast a 99% order and shipping accuracy.
- Our Field Application Engineers and in-house Technical Support Team solve customer and sales issues.
- In fiscal year FY19, sales were \$630 million, growing from \$180 million in fiscal year FY00.
- Allied is a member of Electronic Components Industry Association (ECIA) and National Association of Electrical Distributors (NAED), with many Allied executives serving on a variety of association committees.
