To the Commissioner of Patents:

Hamilton Manufacturing Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, located and doing business at Two Rivers, Wisconsin, and Rahway, New Jersey, and having its principal office at Two Rivers, Wisconsin, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for LABORATORY AND SPECIAL PROFESSIONAL FURNITURE—NAMESLY, BENCHES, DESKS, CHAIRS AND FILING CABINETS; LIBRARY AND SCHOOL ROOM FURNITURE—NAMESLY, BOOKSTACKS, DESKS, SHELF UNITS, TABLES, CHAIRS, MAGAZINE AND NEWSPAPER RACKS, FOOT STOOLS, PORTABLE BOOK DISPLAY RACKS, CARD CATALOGUE CABINETS, DICTIONARY STANDS, BOOK DISPLAY CASES; JUVENILE FURNITURE—NAMESLY, CRIBS, PLAY COOPS, CHAIRS, TABLES, CHIFFOROBES, UTILITY CHESTS, FOOT STOOLS, BEDS AND CLOTHES CABINETS—in Class 32, Furniture and upholstery, and presents herewith five (5) specimens of the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office, in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.

The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business by applicant and applicant's predecessor since the year 1915 in the case of laboratory and special professional furniture; since about March 1, 1938,

in the case of juvenile furniture; and since about February 1, 1940, in the case of library and school room furniture.

The trade-mark is applied to the goods by affixing a plate or other label thereto on which the trade-mark is shown.

Applicant is the owner of registration No. 398,431, dated October 27, 1942, effected on the ground of actual and exclusive use by the applicant of the mark shown therein on the goods recited in said registration for ten years next preceding February 20, 1905, and the mark has been used by the applicant on the articles named in the present application in interstate commerce for at least one year. Applicant is also the owner of registration No. 401,589, registration No. 404,605 and registration No. 405,023.

And the undersigned hereby appoints A.
